Welcome to the 2014 Annual Report from the Texas Association for Infant Mental Health. The Annual Report represents a brief overview of our financial and programmatic highlights. What is especially important to note, is that 2014 has been a year of growth.

The amount of training offered by TAIMH increased by 77% over 2013 while the number of individuals Endorsed by TAIMH more than doubled. Our revenue has increased by 25% since 2012 while our expenses have decreased by 18%. This is all part of TAIMH's long term goal of creating financial stability while increasing our scope and impact around the State. Additionally, through events such as Lakefest and the Infant Mental Health Advocacy Conference, TAIMH has helped promote the importance of the early years, birth to three, across the state. TAIMH cannot accomplish our mission without valuable partners across the State who give their time and money to ensure the healthy development of infants and toddlers in Texas.

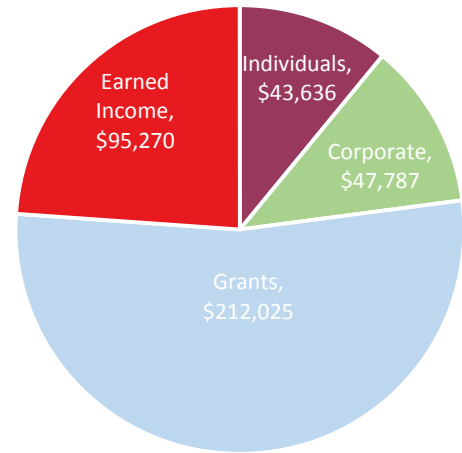

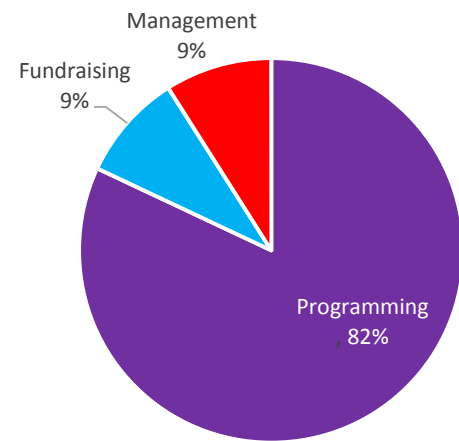


More than 200 professionals joined us in Austin for the 2014 Brazelton Infant Mental Health Conference
